<i>A lovely crisp, fresh dry white wine that was the River Café's house white as well as winner of a Gold medal at the 2014 Sommeliers award. Made by Alberto Antonini it has a fresh, vivacious nose with fresh perfumes of apples and ripe pears with a hint of acacia flower.</i>			
Pinot Grigio – Ponte del Diavola – 2015 -12.5% – Italy – Friuli	£5.20	£7.25	£21.50
<i>Friuli offers a fuller Pinot Grigio than Verona and this is a lovely example. <i>Winner of the prestigious 2011 Decanter magazine International trophy for best Chardonnay this is an outstanding entry level white burgundy. Dry, juicy & elegant it has citrus, apple and pear fruit characters with a lovely streak of minerality on the finish. Very impressive.</i>

<i>One of Decanter's top 50 wines under £25. Intense gold in colour with green tones, this wine has a bright floral nose with the citrus aroma of grapefruit and a hint of spice. In the mouth it is fresh and well structured with a crisp finish. Elegant and fruity with tropical notes to the fore.</i>

<i>A bright straw green colour, the nose reveals intense grassiness combined with green fruits and a hint of tropical exuberance. The palate has marked refreshing acidity, is medium bodied and has a lovely long finish of minerals and expressive fruit. Recommended.</i>			
Pinot Gris, Greywacke. Marlborough 2014 – 13.5% – New Zealand			£37.00
<i>Kevin Judd left Cloudy Bay and set up Greywacke in 2009 and has not looked back. A plush concoction of pears, red apples and quince make for a rich aromatic profile with hints of honeysuckle and spice. The palate has ample body, succulent ripeness in a supple, concentrated just off-dry style.</i>			
Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc. Marlborough 2016 – 13.5% – New Zealand			£45.00

<i>This barrel-fermented Burgundian Chardonnay comes from one of the most esteemed producers in Saint-Aubin. A nose of ripe citrus, fresh peach, subtle sweet spice and hints of minerals, this is followed by gentle hazelnut aromas, lemons and limes, hints of vanilla and butter on the palate</i>			
Puligny Montrachet – Jean-Louis Chavy 2013 13% - French Burgundy			£49.95
<i>Everything a good white Burgundy should be. Vibrant, softly fruity with a lovely gentle complexity. Neither overtly fruity nor over-oaked, Chavy's wines are extremely well balanced, emphasising the classic minerality of Puligny-Montrachet. Scored .92/100 by the wine gang.</i>

Rioja Crianza, El Coto 2013 – 13.5% - Spain – Tempranillo <i>Intense ruby red in colour, the nose is fresh and pronounced. The palate is clean and well balanced, with a core of red and black fruits. The finish is juicy and long. Rioja goes very well with Red meat in general but excellent with herby dishes such as rosemary and Lamb.</i>	£5.30	£7.50	£22.95
Peter Lehman Layers 2014 – 14.5% - Australia, Barossa - Shiraz/temp/mouv/Grenache <i>64% shiraz, 13% Tempranillo, 12% Mouvedre, 11% Grenache this is a lovely balanced wine. Shiraz provides the cherry fruit depth, tempranillo the firmness and savoury, earthiness from mouvedre and all bound together with the aromatic and spicy Grenache. Lirac, Moulin des Chenes 2014 - 14%- Southern Rhone –Syrah, Cinsault, Grenache, Mourvedre, <i>Lirac lies across the river from Chateauneuf in the Rhone valley. Chianti Classico 2013, Fontodi – 14.5% Italy, Sangiovese <i>From one of Chianti's best producers this is deep ruby red in colour, with perfumes of sour cherry and plums leading to notes of leather and tobacco. Great depth of flavour, with juicy fruit and supple tannins, giving the wine a silky-smooth texture.</i>			£39.95
Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Closier De Vaudieu, 2014 – 14.5% –Rhone Valley – Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre <i>Deep ruby red in colour, with a black cherry core. This wine has lively berry fruits on the nose, with a touch of liquorice and a hint of black pepper. Full of fruit, juicy and round with ripe tannins that gently support the cherry, cassis and herb character on the finish.</i>			£44.00
Cote Rotie Maison Nicolas Perrin, 2013 - 13% - Rhone, Syrah <i>The dark colour shows a good concentration. The nose is slightly closed initially but opens up to intense aromas of black fruit and spices. The mouth is silky and elegant with a wonderful long finish.</i>			£75.00
