Montepulciano D'Abruzzo, Il Faggio 2018– 12.5% - Italy, Abruzzo **£5.00** **£7.25** **£20.95**

A deep ruby red in colour, with lifted perfumes of dark fruits, plums and cherries and a hint of mocha. This wine has soft, ripe tannins and a delicious chocolate-cherry finish. Perfect with pork or venison dishes

Malbec, Kaiken Terrior 2017-14.5%- Argentina Mendoza **£6.00** **£8.60** **£25.50**

Part of the Hess family estate this is sourced from high altitude vineyards in Cafayete, Salta. Fruit driven well-structured Malbec with intense fruity aromas of red berries, raspberries & plums with a touch of spiciness & chocolate. Rounded off with soft tannins it has a velvety long finish.

Papa Figos Douro Tinto, Casa Ferreirinha 2017 -12%- Portugal, Douro **£25.95**

Decanter silver award winner and scored 90 in the wine spectator. Intense floral and fruit aromas. On the palate the same red and black fruit shine through with good volume and integrated acidity, lovely elegant finish

Zinfandel 'Heritage Reserve', De Loach 2016– 13.5% California– **£29.95**

Dark in colour, this wine is rich with spice on both the nose and palate. Flavours of ripe strawberry, raspberry and blackberry blend nicely with notes of blackcurrant and molasses. This wine is full bodied with soft tannins and lingering ripe flavours of pomegranate on the finish.

John Duval Shiraz, 2015, Entity – 14.5% – Australia, Barossa Valley **£49.95**

John Duval, one of the men behind Penfolds Grange, possibly Australia's finest red, has set up on his own & made this fantastic wine. Described as one of the top 100 wines and 'ridiculously under-priced' by Simon Hoggart. 'Full and lush on the palate it has an impressively smooth finish.

Orben, Rioja 2015, – 14% - Spain, Rioja **£49.95**

Robert Parker scored this an outstanding 91 points "...aromas of plums, black cherries and plenty of spices and smoke. The palate is lush, medium to full-bodied with abundant but fine tannins that would require some hearty food. Very good example of modern Rioja."

Rioja Reserva Seleccion Especial, Muga, 2011– 14% - Spain, Rioja **£55.00**

Scoring a massive 96 in decanter magazine we had to include this 2nd exceptional Rioja reserva– slightly less brooding than the Orben it is only made in very good years, powerful fruit flavours of black fig and plum, with plenty of smoky vanilla sweetness and the acidity and structure to age.

Barolo 2015, Massolino – 14% - Italy, Piedmont **£57.00**

A very very good wine from a very good producer. James Suckling scored it a 92 and Jancis Robinson called it superior. Full bodied yet elegant the supple smooth tannins give great balance to the dark cherry, plum and clove palate and wonderful long finish. Excellent.

La Reserve de Leoville-Barton, St Julien, 2015 – 13% - Bordeaux Left bank **£59.95**

The 2000 Grand Vin received 96 Parker Points, and the second wine represents great value.- A claret of true class with a classic 'left bank' nose of smoky blackberry fruit & pencil lead, the palate is rich & rounded with assertive tannins, ample fruit & well integrated oak.

Ségla 2012, Margaux – 13% - Bordeaux left bank **£59.95**

Scoring 92 this is a lovely second wine from the Chanel bought Chateau Razan-Ségla that highlights the finesse of Margaux. Fragrant notes of ripe fruits, violets and cedar with beautiful length and delicate tannins. Great structure, balance and a long finish.

Brunello di Montalcino, Poggio San Polo, 2011 /13– 13.5% – Italy, Tuscany, Sangiovese **£80.00**

An intense ruby red with garnet hues. The typical aromas of violets and small red berries are followed by hints of vanilla, cedar and coffee. On the palate it is full-bodied and warm with a densely-woven texture and robust tannins, while the finish is persistent and rounded.

Cepparello, Isole e Olena 2016– 13.5% – Italy, Tuscany, Sangiovese **£120.00**

A great vintage and a great Super Tuscan –concentration, elegance and power. 97 by wine advocate 96 Robert parker says it all

Barolo 'Bussia', Poderi Aldo Conterno 2015 14.5% – Italy, Piedmont, Nebbiolo **£130.00**

From one of Barolo's top producer -outstanding example of Nebbiolo at it's best.
